Application period: April 7 - May 18

Award amount: \$1,000.00

Eligibility requirements (must meet all requirements)

- Member of Abner Baptist Church in good standing as outlined in the church constitution,
- Enrolled in or actively seeking a degree at an accredited institution of higher learning¹ in the U.S.,
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale,
- Financial need, and
- U.S. citizen.

Required application documents (must submit all documents)

- Estes and Ena Anderson Scholarship Program application,
- Current transcript with student name, school name, dates, and grades. Grade reports are not acceptable, and
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) report.

Number of scholarships this program will award per student

Any student who meets all requirements must apply each year he/she wishes to be considered for a scholarship.

Student Obligations

- Provide verification of school enrollment before funds can be dispersed,
- Certify funds are applied to educational expenses such as tuition, room and board, books, supplies, or school fees,
- Remain in good standing with the church and school during the awarded period,
- Notify the committee of any changes in school enrollment, address, or other relevant information, and
- Provide any required support documents to the committee as requested.
